**WKNO Offers Statewide Coverage of the  
109<sup>th</sup> Tennessee General Assembly Sessions**

WKNO, along with Tennessee's other five public television stations, will present annual gavel to gavel coverage of the Tennessee General Assembly of the 109<sup>th</sup> Tennessee General Assembly beginning Tuesday, January 12 at Noon. Sessions will broadcast over the air on WKNO2 on Channel 10.2 and on Comcast Digital Channel 910.

The coverage, which is in partnership with the Tennessee General Assembly, offers citizens a chance to witness their elected representatives in action. In addition to floor sessions, selected committee meetings, where many of the big issues confronting the legislature are debated, will also air. Each week's broadcast schedule will be set by the Tennessee Senate and House on Thursday of the previous week. Viewers can track updates to the schedule by logging on to WKNO.org.
