**WKNO Offers Statewide Coverage of the
111th Tennessee General Assembly Sessions**

Memphis, TN (Tuesday, January 8, 2019) WKNO, along with Tennessee's other five public television stations, will continue to present annual coverage of the 111th Tennessee General Assembly that began today at noon. Coverage of the sessions will broadcast over the air on WKNO2 on Channel 10.2 and on Comcast Digital Channel 910.

The coverage, which is in partnership with the Tennessee General Assembly, offers citizens a chance to witness their elected representatives in action. In addition to floor sessions, selected committee meetings, where many of the big issues confronting the legislature are debated, will also air. Each week's broadcast schedule will be set by the Tennessee Senate and House on Friday of the previous week. Viewers can track updates to the schedule by logging on to WKNO.org.
