WKNO Offers Statewide Coverage of the 113th Tennessee General Assembly Sessions

(Memphis, TN – January 9, 2023) — WKNO, along with Tennessee’s other five public television stations, will continue to present annual coverage of the 113th Tennessee General Assembly that begins Tuesday, January 10 at 12:00 PM. The coverage of the session will be broadcast over the air on WKNO2 (digital channel 10.2 and Comcast digital channel 910 and 1150).

The coverage, which is in partnership with the Tennessee General Assembly, offers citizens a chance to witness their elected representatives in action. In addition to floor sessions, selected committee meetings, where many of the big issues confronting the legislature are debated, will also air. Each week’s broadcast schedule will be set by the Tennessee Senate and House on Friday of the previous week.
